<u>Literacy Learning for Life</u>. The Vermillion Public Schools Foundation is helping to support a three-year commitment to improve the writing skills of our students at the elementary schools. A professional development program to assist the staff will include mentoring and coaching by a visiting professional. Sue Galvin, Jolley School Principal, has a goal for these children "to be lifetime writers."

<u>*High School Scoreboards.*</u> Through a partnership of the Vermillion Athletic Boosters, the School District and First Dakota National Bank, scoreboards were purchased through Daktronics. The two new scoreboards are located on

the soccer/football/track area and in the high school gymnasium. The Athletic Boosters' next project will focus on rehabilitating the high school football and soccer fields.

Our Programs: An Overview

<u>Teacher Grants</u> - Teacher grants enhance the education of the students in the Vermillion School District by encouraging and recognizing new educational approaches and concepts that are not currently funded by the district. The grants provide funding for classroom materials, which make these innovative instructional techniques possible. Teacher grants are made in conjunction with the Vermillion Parent Teacher Organization (PTO).

<u>Scholarships</u> - The Vermillion Public Schools Foundation manages three high school scholarship funds that award four scholarships. There is one middle school scholarship fund. Please consider setting up an endowed scholarship. When an endowment fund reaches \$6,000.00, a percentage of the earnings goes to a payout for a scholarship. The remainder of the earnings are returned to the fund for growth. No percentage of the earnings go toward Foundation expenses.
