Accomplishments by Vermillion Booster Groups:

<u>Athletic Booster Club</u>: The Vermillion Athletic Boosters completed the grandstand and coaches' boxes at the Veterans Sports Complex (more in newsletter). The Athletic Booster's Inaugural Golf Fundraiser, held on May 19, 2018, raised \$2,500 towards the sports complex. The Winning Team consisted of Nick Olson, Amber and Jon Brooks, and Tyler Brown. The VHS Boys Cross-Country team won State Runner Up this October.

<u>Vermillion Area Robotics Club</u>: The Vermillion High School Robotics Team won Tournament Champion for Robot Skills at tournaments in Groton, SD and Omaha, NE this past October. Their Robot Skills (driver and programming) score, posted in Omaha, has them placed 9th in the World!

<u>Music Boosters</u>: The Pride of Vermillion Marching Band took home several awards at the 2018 Quad State Competition: First place in Group IVA; Caption Award for Best Music; and Caption Award for Best Overall Effect.

<u>VHS Educational Trips</u>: Two educational trips for VHS students are planned for Summer 2019. VHS Drama students were selected to perform in Edinburgh, Scotland in August, 2019. Another group of VHS students will participate in a 10-day, four central European country tour to study WWII and the Holocaust. All are busy fundraising for their great learning adventures.
